Pump Station 18 Site Tree Clearing

The Madison Metropolitan Sewerage District will receive proposals for clearing of trees from the future MMSD Pump Station 18 site. Proposals will be received at the office of the District, 1610 Moorland Road, Madison, Wisconsin 53713, until **1:00 p.m. on Thursday, August 18, 2011**, at which time and place all proposals will be publicly opened and read aloud.

Proposals shall be addressed to the Madison Metropolitan Sewerage District; Mr. Michael Mucha, Chief Engineer and Director; 1610 Moorland Road; Madison, Wisconsin 53713; and shall be marked "Sealed Proposal, Pump Station 18 Site Tree Clearing."

The site is located adjacent to and south of the UW Health Yahara Clinic which is under construction at 1050 East Broadway, Monona, WI, 53716. The trees to be cleared are between the new clinic and the adjacent waterway. There are approximately 164 trees to be removed which are greater than 4" in diameter. The average diameter is 12 inches. The majority of the trees to be cleared are cottonwood and box elder. Additional trees to be removed include willow, elm, birch, ash, and mulberry. CONTRACTOR will be able to start on or after August 29, 2011, and the CONTRACTOR shall complete the clearing operation no later than October 14, 2011.

A pre-bid meeting will be held at **10:00 a.m. on Monday, August 15, 2011**, at the District office, 1610 Moorland Road, Madison, Wisconsin. All prospective bidders are encouraged to attend.
