The Madison Metropolitan Sewerage District will hold a public hearing on **Thursday, October 5, 2017** at 6:30 p.m. at the Nine Springs Wastewater Treatment Plant, 1610 Moorland Road, Madison, WI, 53713. The purpose of the hearing is to receive public input regarding submission of a liquid processing facilities plan to the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources. The plan provides recommendations for improvements to the district's facilities for peak flow management, headworks screening, grit removal and hauled waste receiving, activated sludge process, disinfection of effluent and electrical reliability through the Year 2040. The plan is available for public inspection at the Nine Springs Wastewater Treatment Plant on weekdays from 7:30 a.m. – 4 p.m. It will also be made available for viewing at the district's website (www.madsewer.org).
