

#### Background

- Commission Meeting 2/13/2020:
  - Staff presented an update and requested an increase in consulting fees due to scope changes (bridge, updated entrance/landscaping, among others)
  - Staff indicated scope changes would increase project cost to estimated \$2.2 million, but a formal increase would not be requested until bidding time.
  - Now we have bid the project so are requesting an increase, but less than anticipated.



#### **Bidding**

- Significant interest in the project, with 9 contractors pre-qualifying and submitting bids
- Very competitive bids, favorable bidding climate
- Bids are close overall, indicating a clear project scope

#### Low Bidder

- Kenneth F Sullivan qualified, financially stable, and provided responsive bid (included all required documents).
- MMSD has not worked with them before however they have extensive prior experience with this type of work.
- They are comfortable with their bid and look forward to working with the District



#### Financial Impact

 Current total project cost estimate incorporating bid results is \$2,050,000:

	2020 Budget	Current Estimate
Construction Cost plus Contingency plus Other Costs (permits, etc.)	\$1,444,000	\$1,655,000
Professional Services & MMSD Staff Time	\$285,000	\$395,000
Total Project Cost	\$1,729,000	\$2,050,000

- Current estimate is less than \$2.2M estimate presented in Feb. 2020 following scope increases.
- 2021 Capital Budget will be adjusted to reflect the current estimate.



#### Requested Action & Next Steps


- Approve resolution to:

    Co., at their low bid price of \$1,566,525
- Next steps:
  - Finalize contract
  - Begin construction in October







#### Conceptual Plan

- Directs all visitors, including those with disabilities, to a single welcoming entrance
- Improved security
- Separates lab and offices
- More cohesive office area
- Common cafeteria, gender-neutral bathroom and comfort/first aid room
- Allows for future addition



#### Scope increase

- New plan meets project goals, but to do so, additional scope items are needed:
  - Pedestrian Bridge
  - Revitalization of the main entrance
- Need an amendment to the design services contract
