## Handbook Language

#### **Current Definition of Part-Time Employee**

 An employee who is regularly scheduled to work less than 40 hours per week. Part-time employees working at least 30 hours per week may be eligible for certain benefits, provided they meet the requirements of the benefit plans. Proposed Definition of Part-Time Employee

 An employee who is regularly scheduled to work between 24 - 40 hours per week for longer than 1 year. Part-time employees are eligible for paid leave and benefits, provided they meet the requirements of the benefit plans.
