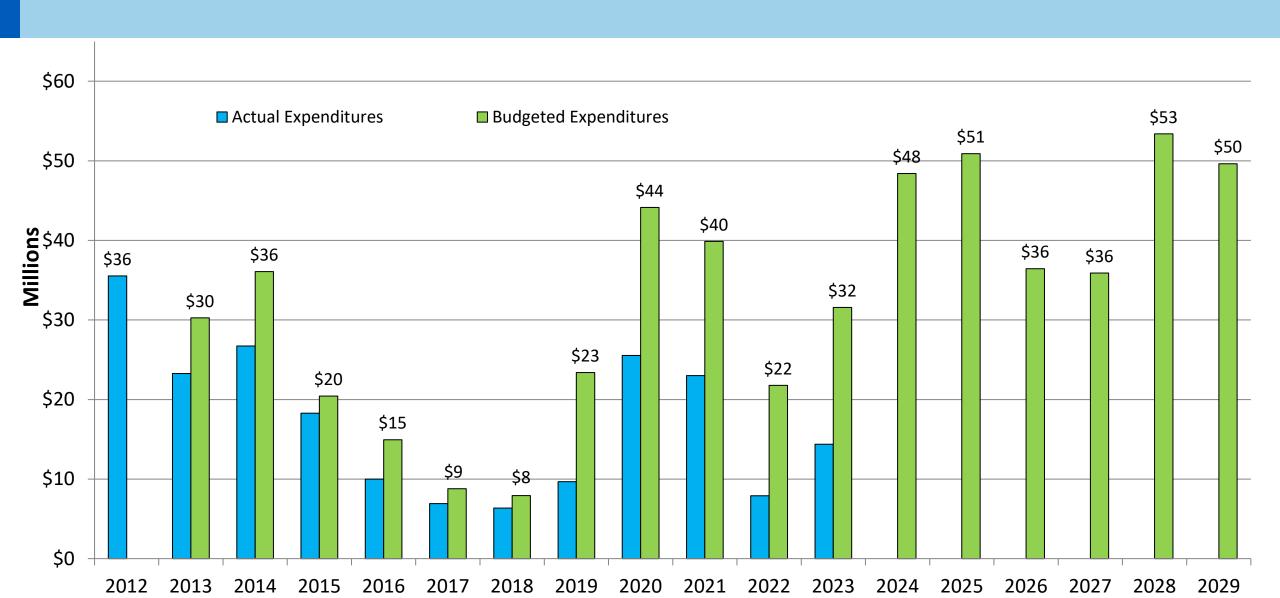

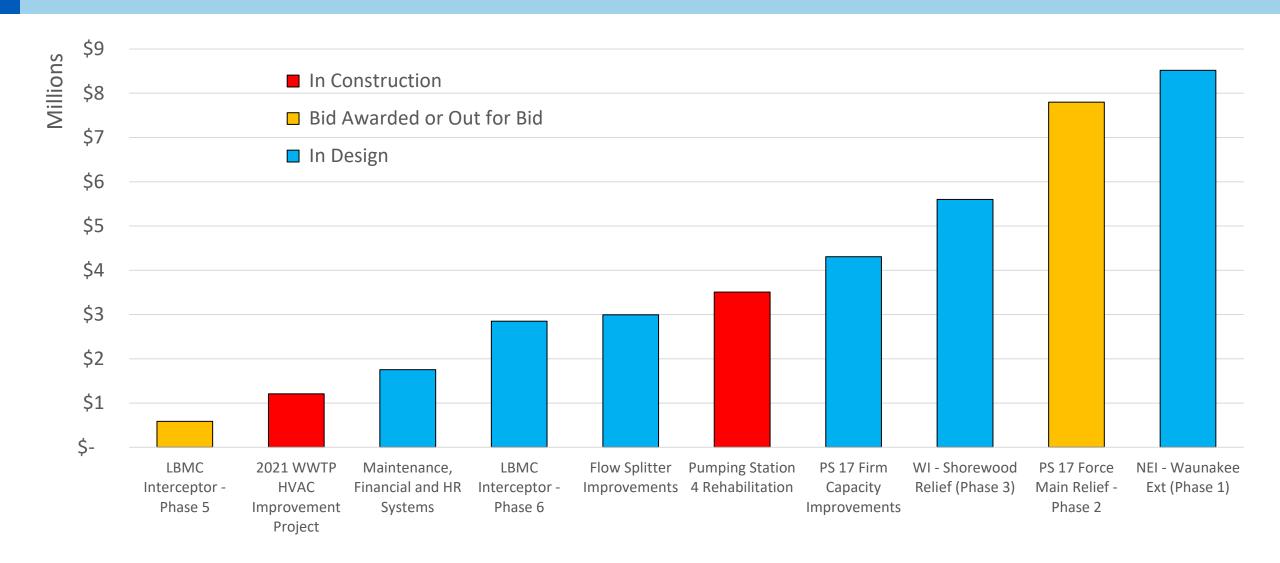

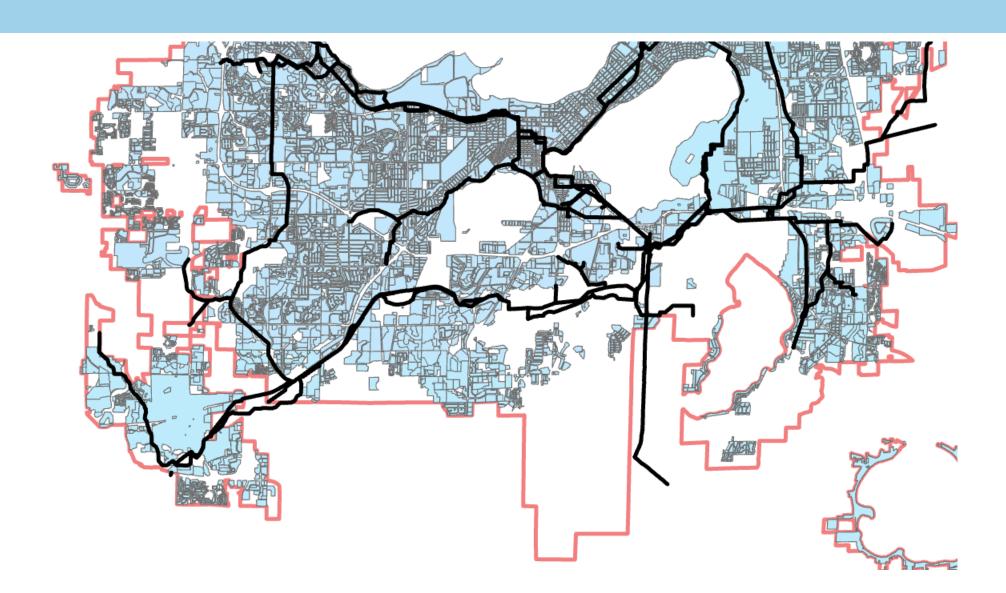

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Connection Charge Revenue

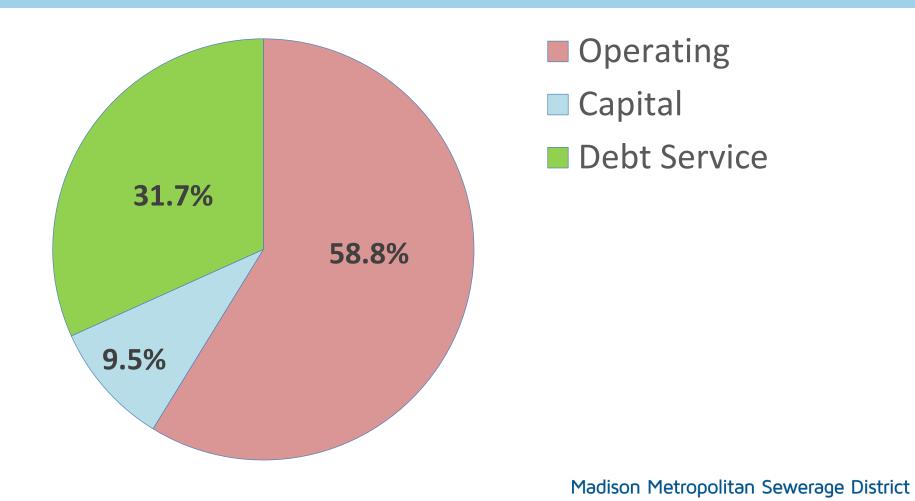
- 1. Treatment plant connection charges connection charge for use of treatment plant facilities

Connection Charge Revenue



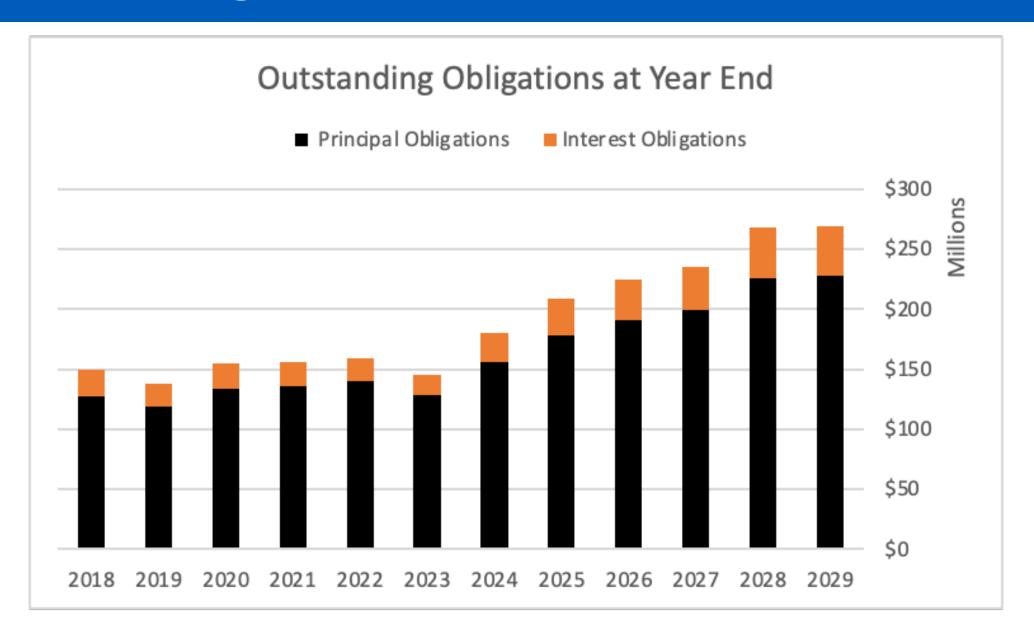
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Allocation of Service Charge Revenue

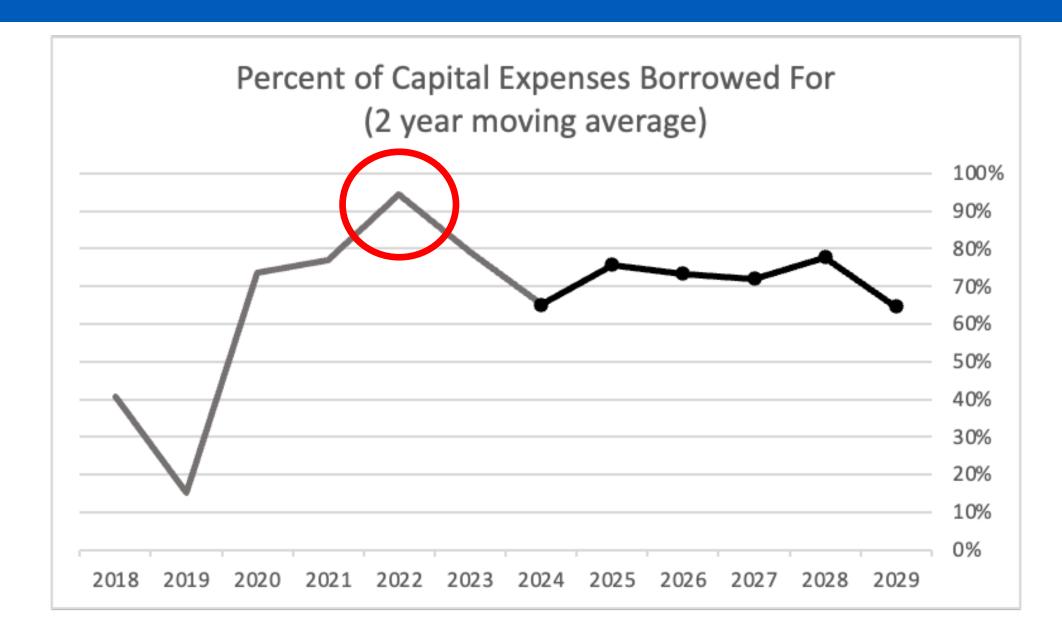


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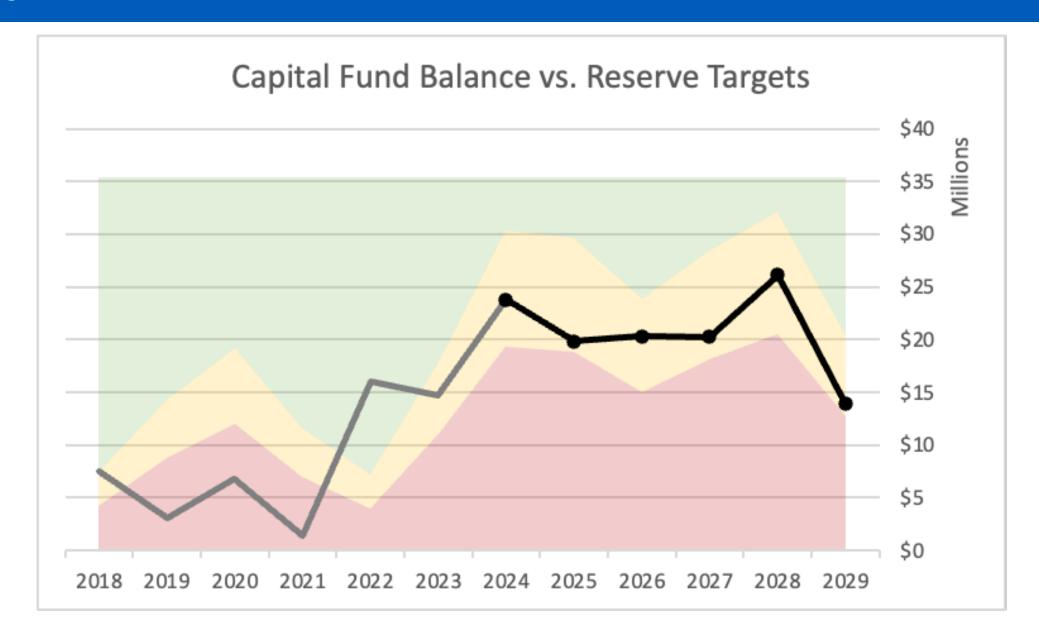
Debt — Obligations



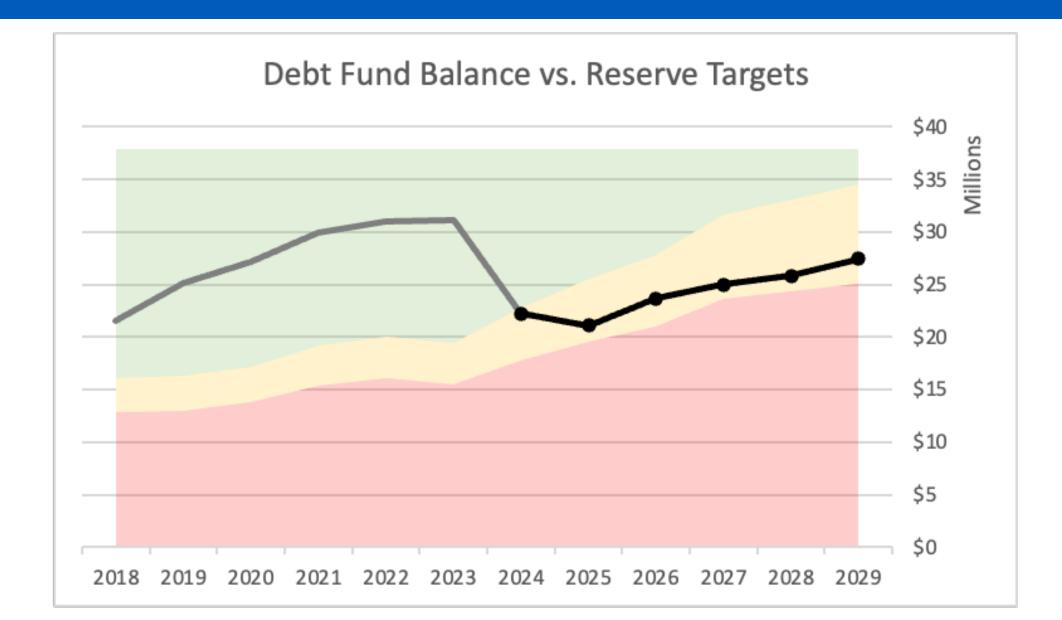
Debt — Percent Borrowed For



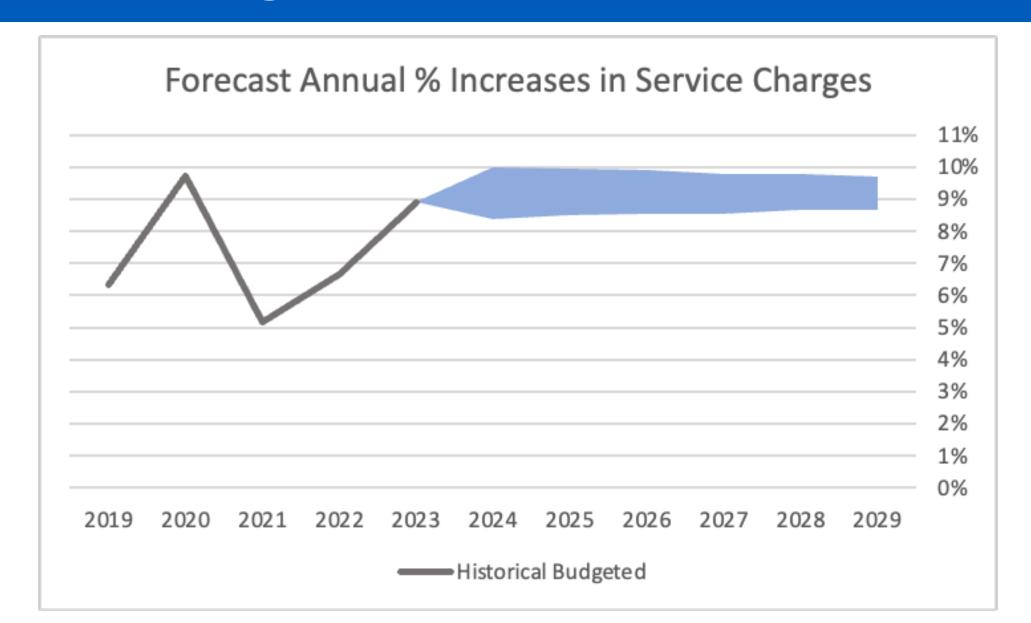
Capital Fund Reserves

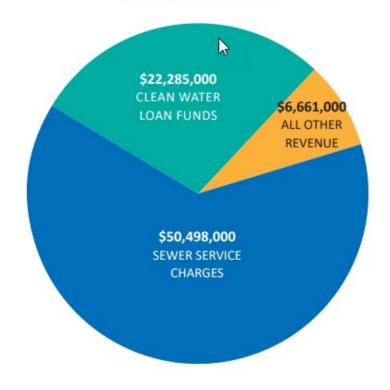
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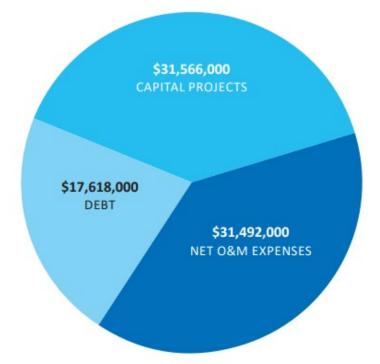
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Combined Revenues & Expenditures (2021-2023)
