

Trash the Fats, Oils & Grease

When fats, oils and grease (FOG) or dairy products go down the drain, there are consequences for your home and your community.

- Coats pipes, which slows drains and disposers
- Creates unpleasant odors in your kitchen pipes
- Clogs sewer laterals and system infrastructure, resulting in sewer backups in your home and leaks in the community
- Causes pollution in local waterways



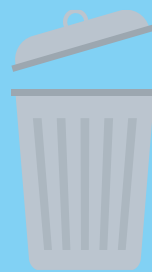
COOL IT

Chill FOG in the fridge or to room temp before tossing



SCRAPE IT

Scrape solid grease into a lined trash can



CAN IT

Collect liquid grease and oil in a container



WIPE IT

Wipe grease and debris with a paper towel

**Properly dispose of FOG and dairy.
Put it in the trash, not down the drain.**
